APPENDIX F – PNA+ COALITION FIRST YEAR ACTION PLAN

Over a nearly two-year period (October 2023–May 2025), the PNA+ Implementation Plan was developed through deep collaboration between the County of Los Angeles Department of Parks and Recreation (LA County Parks) and a coalition of 15 community-based organizations. This process not only produced a comprehensive countywide strategy, but also built a strong foundation for continued partnership among LA County Parks, the three State Conservancies in LA County, and the PNA+ Coalition to advance shared goals.
